Subject: Relaxation in the provisions contained in Para 9.2.6 of the C&AG's MSO (Admin) Vol-I-reg.

Sir/Madam,

In accordance with the provisions contained in Para 9.2.6 of the C&AG's Manual of Standing Orders (Administrative) Vol-I, "only persons who have put in minimum of 3 years continuous service in one or more of the following capacities in a particular field office of IA&AD and who had successfully completed their probation period are eligible to appear in the SAS examination":

- (i) As a Clerk / Accountant / Sr. Accountant in an Accounts Office.
- (ii) As a Clerk/ Auditor / Sr. Auditor in an Audit Office.
- (iii) As a Data Entry Operator/Console Operator/Senior Console Operator in an Accounts Office/ Audit Office.
- (iv) As a Stenographer/Personal Assistant/ Private Secretary in an Accounts Office/Audit Office.
- (v) As a Divisional Accountant/Divisional Accounts Officer Grade-II under the administrative control of a Principal Accountant General/Accountant General (A&E).
- (vi) As a Junior Translator/Senior Translator in an Accounts Office/ Audit Office.
- (vii) As a Supervisor in an Accounts Office/ Audit Office.

2. Considering the shortage in the AAOs cadre in field offices, it was decided by the Competent Authority to relax the above provision and allow the eligible officials with 2 years continuous service in one or more of the capacities in a particular field office and who had successfully completed their probation to appear in the Subordinate Audit/Accounts Service Examination for 2015 also.

3. In view of the prevailing shortage in the AAO cadre, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the above relaxation for SAS-2016 (Main) Examination also. The officials who would be completing 2 years continuous service in one or more capacities in a particular field office of IA&AD and who would be successfully completing their probation period on the first day of the month in which SAS (Main) Examination 2016 is scheduled, shall be allowed to appear in the SAS-2016 (Main) Examination.

4. Further, such officials who are yet to complete their probation in a particular field office, but are likely to complete the same on the first day of the month in which the SAS-2016 (Main) Examination would be scheduled, may be allowed to appear in the SAS (Preliminary) Test and in case of passing the SAS (Preliminary) Test, registered as a candidate for the ensuing SAS 2016 (Main) Examination. In case of failure to complete the probation period successfully on the first day of the month in which SAS-2016 (Main) Examination is scheduled, the candidature of such officials should be cancelled. This would however, not be counted as an attempt at the SAS Examination.

5. Heads of the Departments shall ensure that no ineligible candidate is allowed to appear in the SAS Examination 2016.
