CIRCULAR

Sub Calling for applications from eligible candidates to appear at the ensuing Annual SAS (Civil Accounts/Audit) for both Group-I /II / Incentive / CPD-I Examination to be held in August 2016.

The next Annual/Main Subordinate Audit/Accounts Service examination, Incentive Examination for Sr.AO/AO/AAO and Continuous Professional Development-I Test for Sr.AO/AO/AAO/Sr.DAO/DAO-Gr-I is scheduled to be held in the month of August -2016.

The eligibility criteria to appear in SAS (Audit/Accounts)/I/CPD-I Examination of August 2016 is as below:-

SAS Examination

- Officials who have successfully passed the SAS (Accounts) Preliminary Examination conducted during 2013 and 2016 and completed the mandatory pre-examination training are eligible to appear the said examination subject to condition that they would be completing two years continuous service in one or more capacities and would be successfully completing their probation period as on 01.08.2016. In case of failure to complete the probation period successfully on 01.08.2016, the candidature of such officials shall be cancelled.
  - Divisional Accountant / Divisional Accounts Officer Grade-II who have completed their probation period of 2 years successfully and confirmed in the cadre on passing the Divisional Accountant Grade Examination as on 01.08.2016 are eligible to appear the said examination.
  - SAS (Audit) for A&E officials: Fresh candidates from A&E Offices will not be allowed to appear in the SAS (Audit) Examination 2016. However, such of the Group 'B' and 'C' Officials who have already appeared in the SAS (Audit) Examination in previous years and still have some papers to clear and are yet to exhaust their chances would be allowed to appear in the SAS (Audit) August 2016 Examination. However, candidates after getting promotion as Accounts Officer cannot be allowed to appear in SAS examination 2016.
- The existing A&E officials who are still appearing in SAS (Audit) Examination for their eventual absorption in Audit offices on attaining the age of 56 years at the time of holding of SAS examination, are not permitted to appear in SAS (Audit) Examination 2016.

NB:- Calling of applications from the candidates other than above, would be considered on receipt of clarification from Hdqrs Office.

Incentive Examination

Sr. Accounts Officer's / Accounts Officers / Assistant Accounts Officers / Assistant Accounts Officer (RT) in A&E offices, who have put in one year continuous service in the grade as on 01.08.2016 are eligible to appear in Incentive examination.
